<u>IPHC-2023-WM2023-</u> <u>PropA3</u>	Logs (Sect 19) – Update and alignment of log requirements	To update and align log requirements for Contracting Parties in the IPHC Fishery Regulations.



Proposal A3: Update and alignment of log requirements

- Component 1: Submission of missing logs
- Component 2: Consistent reporting requirements
- Component 3: List of eligible logbooks
- Component 4: Writing in the logs
- Component 5: Electronic logbooks approved by NOAA Fisheries
- Component 6: Electronic logbooks approved by IPHC

This proposal (except component 4) directly affects commercial Pacific halibut fishery in all USA IPHC Regulatory Areas. However, all sectors and regions stand to benefit from better informed IPHC products, for example, the Pacific halibut stock assessment.
