This permit is issued to the Makah Tribe – Makah Fisheries Management. Permission is extended for activities as follows:

- 1) Activity: to tag and release Pacific halibut (*Hippoglossus stenolepis*) for research purposes;
- 2) Location: Usual and Accustomed area (U&A) of the Makah Tribe, Washington, USA;
- 3) Total number of Pacific halibut permitted: 10
- 4) Permissible fishing gear: Hook-and-line
- 5) **Permissible time period:** 18 April 2024 through 31 October 2024;
- 6) **Principal contact:** William Jasper, (360) 645-3157
- 7) Vessel: R/V dač?oł (WN246MKH)

Pacific halibut obtained under this permit may not be retained for purposes other than the scientific research programs described herein.

1) A maximum of ten (10) Pacific halibut (90-100 cm fork length) will be assessed for hooking injury, measured for length, tissue-sampled for sex determination, and tagged with a Wildlife Computers MiniPAT satellite tag. Numbers, estimated weights, and other data collected from captured and released Pacific halibut must be reported to the International Pacific Halibut Commission.

Pacific halibut captured but not used in the study specified in this permit must be returned to the sea with a minimum of delay or injury as required by IPHC Fishery Regulations (2024).
