



Dr. Michael (Mike) Wilberg Biography

Dr. Mike Wilberg is a Professor of fisheries science at the University of Maryland Center for Environmental Science's Chesapeake Biological Laboratory in Solomons, Maryland. He teaches graduate courses on fisheries science and management, and population dynamics and stock assessment.

Research in Dr. Wilberg's lab includes development, implementation, and testing of stock assessment methods, management strategy evaluation, quantitative fisheries ecology, and marine ecology. His work spans species from mysids to whales, marine to terrestrial environments, and locations around the world. In addition to serving on the

Scientific Review Board of the IPHC, he is also the vice chairperson of the Mid-Atlantic Fishery Management Council's Scientific and Statistical Committee and co-convenor of the International Whaling Commission's Implementation and Simulation Trials group.
