

Commissioner Neil Davis Biography

Neil Davis was appointed Commissioner to the IPHC on June 12, 2018. Mr. Davis is the Director of Program Delivery with Fisheries and Oceans Canada at their Regional Headquarters in Vancouver, British Columbia. Mr. Davis oversees the management of non-salmon fisheries, marine mammals, and marine species at risk on Canada's Pacific coast.

Mr. Davis joined Fisheries and Oceans Canada in 2009 as a Senior Program Manager for Integrated Oceans Management in Pacific region before becoming the Groundfish Regional Manager in 2012. This role entailed responsibility for the management of halibut, multi-species bottom

trawl, hake, sablefish, rockfish, lingcod, and dogfish fisheries and consultation with a diversity of Indigenous, commercial, recreational, and non-governmental parties. In this role, he also served as an advisor to Canadian Commissioners at the IPHC.

Mr. Davis holds a Bachelor of Science in Natural Resources Conservation and a Master of Science degree in Fisheries Management from the University of British Columbia.
