Washington South Coast (Marine Area 2) Nearshore sport halibut fishery to close Sunday, July 19

The Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife estimates that the South Coast (Marine Area 2) recreational fishery had taken 3,819 pounds as of July 12th, and it is projected that the remaining quota will be taken during the week of July 13-19, 2015. Therefore the Marine Area 2 northern nearshore fishery will close at the end of the day on Sunday, July 19th.
