Topic: 2015 Stock assessment modeling

- **1.** Aspects of data analysis that should be prioritized for the remainder of 2015, and in the future.
- **2.** Aspects of model development should be prioritized for the remainder of 2015, and in the future.
- 3. Current understanding and analysis of movement rates.
- 4. The coastwide and area-specific MSE modelling.
- 5. The SPR-based management framework.
- 6. Additional comments on research priorities.
